ORNL (Keith Kline and Maggie Davis) continued to support the initiative to develop an International Organization for Standardization (ISO) standard on "Sustainability Criteria for Bioenergy" (ISO 13065) by planning, and facilitating and participating in 16 webinars, consolidating comments, identifying issues and proposing solutions. Kline was selected to lead the 18-member international editing committee toward consensus on a first "committee draft" document that will be distributed for review in September and discussed in the next TC-248 plenary meeting in January 2013.

Aug 24 – Latha Baskaran presented a talk "Effects of switchgrass related land-use changes on aquatic macroinvertebrates" at the Fishheads seminar series in ORNL.

On August 27, Virginia Dale met with Kristen Johnson (DOE EERE) in Washington, DC, and they discussed the Joule 4 Milestone on indicators and targets for bioenergy sustainability, the Council on Sustainable Biomass Production (CSBP), and other activities in which ORNL is engaged.

Researchers from across the State of Tennessee contributed information to this 72-page report led by ORNL's Climate Change Science Institute (CCSI). The report will be presented to the Mayor of Nashville and other Tennessee leaders in business, government, and nongovernmental organizations at a conference planned for September 11, 2012.
